

40 pence for 40 days



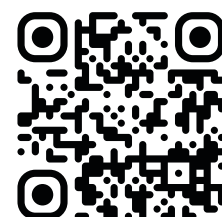
By giving up 40 pence a day for the 40 days of Lent you can support local individuals and families facing hardship this Easter.
